

Responsibilities of Board of Directors Members

Mission Statement

The mission of the Community Child Guidance Clinic is to assist and support children with emotional and behavioral issues by providing a special education day school and a system of child and family-focused mental health services.

Board Overview

CCGC Board members serve a three-year term and are eligible to serve two consecutive terms. The CCGC Board meets a minimum of ten times during the year, usually at 7:00 p.m. on the fourth Monday of the month. Board members should make every effort to attend all of the Board meetings. A Board member who is absent for two consecutive meetings without approval of the Board president may be removed from the Board.

Fundamental Legal Duties of Nonprofit Board of Directors Members

- Duty of Care Each board member has a legal responsibility to participate actively in making decisions on behalf of the organization and to exercise his or her best judgment while doing so.
- Duty of Loyalty Each board member must put the interests of the organization before their personal and professional interests when acting on behalf of the organization in a decision-making capacity. The organization's needs come first.
- Duty of Obedience Board members bear the legal responsibility of ensuring that the organization complies with the applicable federal, state, and local laws and adheres to its mission.

CCGC Board Member Responsibilities

- Understand and support CCGC's mission, programs, and services.
- Be familiar with the board's bylaws.
- Review the agenda and supporting materials prior to all board meetings.
- Actively participate in board meetings and board decisions.
- Actively participate in the ongoing fiscal oversight of CCGC.
- Annually make a meaningful, personal financial contribution to CCGC at a level reasonable to the individual.
- Serve on one or more board committees.
- Attend and support CCGC fundraising events as often as possible but at least once a year.
- Abide by the conflict of interest and confidentiality policies of CCGC.
- Participate in the periodic review of the board's and the agency's efficacy and the evaluation of the Chief Operating Officer's performance.
- Assist in identifying and recruiting new board members.
- Advocate for and promote CCGC whenever possible.
